



Open Position: Trauma Therapist

Preparation: Requires a Master's Degree in Social Work, Counseling, or related field. Licensed in the State of Michigan to provide therapy interventions. Individuals with a limited license will be considered with relevant experience. Bilingual English/Spanish a plus. At least two years of clinical experience and a working knowledge of trauma-informed therapeutic services preferred. An ideal candidate would be an experienced public speaker.

Job Summary: Provide individual and group trauma-informed therapeutic interventions to adults and teens who have experienced intimate partner and/or sexual violence. Requires ability to provide clinical assessment, establish rapport, safety plan, and provide trauma informed therapeutic interventions. Provides crisis intervention 4-8 hours a work week and serves as staff on call after hours about 4 weeks a year. This position also has opportunities to provide therapeutic services to children who have been exposed to domestic violence perpetrated on adults, if the applicant has interest and training or a willingness to be trained in trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy and/or other evidence-based, trauma-informed modalities for children.
